Fourth and Fifth Grade Extra Credit Form *(updated 8/25/06)*

Each quarter, fourth and fifth grade students have the capability to earn up to 10 extra credit points by participating in an extra curricular musical activity. Below are some examples of approved activities. While I applaud those students that could earn more than 10 points, that is all I will be awarding! Students need to show the responsibility to turn in the forms by the due dates listed below. On the reverse side of this page is a form your child can fill out for easy verification.

DUE DATES: for me to get my grades into the classroom teachers in time, I will need all assignments and extra credit points turned in by the following dates:

1st Quarter: 11/3/06

2nd Quarter: 3/2/07

3rd Quarter: 6/8/07

1. **Performing Group:** Students who participate in a choir, band, or orchestra can earn 1 extra credit point for each hour of rehearsal. They should receive written verification from their director and parent.
2. **Private Lessons:** Students who take music lessons, can earn 1 extra credit point for each hour of lesson time. They should receive written verification from their instructor and parent.
3. **Concert Observation:** Students can go to an approved live performance, write a short paragraph sharing what they observed, and earn 1 extra credit point.
4. **Music Project:** Students can produce a special music project to earn extra credit points. This could include a written report, oral report, poster, web page, etc. about a musical group, composer, or period. These projects need to be pre-approved by Mrs. Hamp.
5. **Other Ideas:** If you have an idea that you think should be approved, and it is not listed above, please feel free to present a proposal to Mrs. Hamp.

To earn extra credit points in music, I have accomplished the following activities. I realize I can only earn up to 10 extra credit points per quarter, and that each hour of lessons or rehearsal time with an instructor earns me 1 extra credit point.
