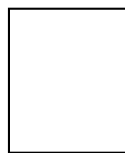

- F. Play the poem using notes B, A, G, E and low D. Suggestions: move mostly stepwise, have a similarity between the 1st and 2nd halves, think about the words in your melody selection. Rule: End on "Do"!
- G. If you liked the way your song sounded, write the letter names of the notes on the spaces under your rhythm. Have a friend check it.
